DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Commands the Headquarters and Headquarters Company with an authorized strength of 69 soldiers. Responsible for commanding , planning and executing a training program for the unit to ensure Soldiers are proficient in METL tasks and MOS skills. Responsible for MTOE equipment valued over \$4 million dollars with a quantity of over 900 items of equipment. Responsible for the morale, discipline, and welfare of assigned Soldiers in the company. Ensures the company is in compliance with army regulations and all safety guidelines. Responsible for maintaining the proper condition, readiness, and accountability of all personnel, weapons, and equipment. Ensures overall planning and resourcing for training is aimed at attaining and sustaining a high state of readiness to mobilize, deploy and redeploy for state and federal missions.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Graduate of Basic Officer Leaders Course required. Graduate of the Company Level Pre-Command Course and the LG Captain's Career Course strongly preferred. 5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements (mandatory for applicants) within six months of the board date. Include the DA Form 5500-R/5501-R if the officer exceeds the authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
