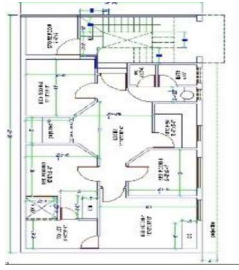

Programs/Courses:

- Autodesk: Computer Aided Drafting/Design (CAD) & Revit {evening course(s)-open enrollment}
- Construction Academy {5 days/wk for 13 weeks w/certs- **MD Works for Wind Grant: Free for eligible and selected applicants**}

- A. Electrical Wiring Technician-Introduction {Pre-Apprenticeship evening-open enrollment course- **Free via ARPA Scholarship**}



- B. Independent Electrical Contractors (IEC) Non-Union Apprenticeship {evening courses}

- A. HVAC: Certification courses {evening courses-open enrollment-**AC&R-Intro II is free for successful AC&R-Intro I students through the MD Works for Wind Grant**}

- B. HVAC EPA+GWP, MD Stationary Engineer Certification I and II Preparation courses {evenings-open enrollment for established technicians}



- Powerline Worker Pre-Apprenticeship Training: Partnership with VA, MD & DE Association of Electric Coops {13 weeks, FT-all day Monday through Friday- **MD Works for Wind Grant: Free for eligible and selected applicants**} + CDL Training {8 weeks-FT Mon-Fri- **Free for PWPA grads through MWV Grant**}

- Manufacturing: Soldering and blueprint reading courses beginning Fall 2025!

- Machining and Metal Fabrication- 228 hrs for ~19 weeks- Mon/Wed/Fri, 5:00-9:00pm with OSHA 10 cert (**MD EARN Grant: Free for eligible and selected applicants**)

- A. Introduction to Plumbing Pre-Apprenticeship {May or June evening course}

- B. Plumbing Non-Union Apprenticeship (Partnered w/ Associated Builders & Contractors (ABC)- Chesapeake Shores) {evening courses}



- Water/Wastewater Treatment courses through MCET {day courses}

- A. Welding (Stick, MIG, Flux-Core & TIG)- 352 hrs for ~18 wks- Monday-Friday, 8:00am-12:00pm w/ up to 12 welding qualifications (**Maryland EARN Grant: Free for eligible & selected applicants**)

- B. MIG/TIG & Arc Welding: Introduction course + MIG/TIG & Arc Welding-Intermediate with welding qualification testing course is **free via an ARPA Scholarship** for successful Intro completers {both courses are evenings and/or Saturdays-open enrollment}



- C. Advanced Welding: 6G Pipe {Evenings-**MD Works for Wind Grant: Free for eligible and selected applicants**-2 yrs experience required}
