Directs, observes, and evaluates effectiveness of training programs, availability and combat readiness of assigned crews, and operation and adequacy of support activities.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

They must also be current in all Individual Medical Readiness (IMR) requirements to include immunizations.
