WHO MAY APPLY: OPEN TO CURRENT ENLISTED (SrA/E4-Sgt/E5) MEMBERS OF THE MARYLAND AIR NATIONAL GUARD AND THOSE ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP.

QUALIFICATION/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Refer to ANGI 36-101, The Active Guard/Reserve Program, for general eligibility requirements for initial entry into the AGR Program and specific guidelines for utilization, and assignment of currently on-board AGR members.
2. Applicants must meet the physical qualifications outlined in AFI 48-123, Medical Examination and Standards.
3. Applicant must meet weight requirements at the time of entry into the AGR Program. Any member on the ANG Fitness Improvement Program is ineligible for entry into AGR status.
4. Applicant should be able to complete 20 years of active duty service prior to mandatory separation.
5. Category 1 AGR resources (recruiters, security forces, range, air defense, civil support) are fenced and are not able to move AGR asset.
6. Highly desired that member have completed the appropriate level of PME corresponding to their grade/rank.

BRIEF OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Survey Team Member performs duties as part of a highly specialized team tasked with a nationwide, no-notice mission to identify, sample, render safe, mitigate, and decontaminate chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear (CBRN) material during incidents involving the suspected use of Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD). Survey Team Member is responsible for conducting reconnaissance and sampling operations in potentially contaminated environments while wearing the appropriate level of personal protective equipment (PPE). Survey Team member is proficient in NBC antidote administration, casualty extraction, crime scene/evidence preservation techniques and WMD CST chain of custody (sample transfer) procedures. Survey Team Member supports the crisis and consequence management of CBRN incidents for local, state, and federal agencies. Survey Team member is responsible for the maintenance, operation, and accountability of personal, team, and section equipment. Survey Team Member performs all other duties as assigned

SPECIAL INFORMATION (IF APPLICABLE)

1. Official notification to applicants of selection or non-selection is by letter from the Human Resources Office (HRO).
2. Existing MDANG promotion policies apply
3. May be authorized PCS IAW the JFTR.
4. Appropriate military uniform will be worn during duty hours
5. The Civil Support Skills Course (CSSC) incurs a 36-month Stabilized Tour Agreement that starts the day of graduation.
4. Initial tours are 48 months. Follow on tour lengths may be 1-6 years.

5. Must currently have or be able to obtain a SECRET clearance.
6. Must be willing and able to meet all 32nd WMD CST conditions of assignment. See attached document.
7. Must relocate to within one-hour driving distance (approx.50 miles) of Fort Meade.
8. Must be able to perform moderate to heavy work in all OSHA Levels of Personal Protective Ensembles (PPE) to include fully encapsulated suits with self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) or (BG4 Re-breathers) for up to 4 hours per day.
9. Must pass a comprehensive WMD-CST/OSHA compliant history and physical examination to determine medical fitness for WMD-CST duty.
10. Must participate in the team medical surveillance program and receive mandatory CRE vaccinations to include Anthrax and Smallpox.
11. Position often requires short notice and frequent temporary duty; team members are on call for emergency CBRN response 24/7/365 days per year unless on leave or TDY. Unscheduled TDY may occur so applicants must have valid family support plans if required.
12. IAW CNGBM 3501.00 personnel with a history of Physical Profile capacity of P-3 or higher IAW AR 40- 501 are eligible for assignment. Candidates who do not meet the minimum physical and psychological requirements are not eligible for assignment.
13. The WMD-CST health care provider will review the results to determine eligibility for placement and make a recommendation to the Commander.
14. Prior experience in emergency management or as a first responder is ideal but not required.
15. Must have a score of at least 62 in the general (G) qualification area of the ASVAB.
