WHO MAY APPLY: **Open to traditional MDAY Soldiers, on board T32/T10 NCOs holding the Automatic Logistical Specialist (92A) MOS. This is a traditional M-Day position.**

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: The A CO. 529 DSSB First Sergeant acts as the principal advisor to the Alpha Company Commander. They are the senior Noncommissioned Officer within Alpha Company and as such, they advise the Commander on all enlisted matters. The 529 DSSB is comprised of the Headquarters element, an operations section, a maintenance, supply platoon, stock control, receiving, and storage sections, multiple packing and crate sections, a postal platoon, and a collections team. The 1SG should work on helping the Senior NCOs develop organizational leadership skills needed to coach, teach, and mentor Soldiers. They are responsible for the health, discipline, morale, and welfare of the entire Company. They serve as the Senior Enlisted Trainer and work in conjunction with the Platoon Sergeants. They are instrumental in coaching, mentoring, and developing the enlisted soldiers within the Company.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: **Must hold the 92A MOS Must hold a Secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9, and AR 40-502. Applicants must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions. Must be in grade of E8 or a promotable E7 at the time of selection. Must have extensive experience in CMF92, with thorough understanding and knowledge of medical support principles, policies, regulations, operations, and organization. Must possess an in-depth knowledge of the organization and mission of A Co. 529 DSSB.**
