SECTION III: DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES					
<p>Open to traditional MDAY Soldiers and on board T32 NCOs holding the 74D CMF, and those who are currently on the MDARNG 1SG BQ List. Additionally, all previous 1SGs holding the SQI "M" are eligible to apply. This is a traditional M-Day position. Applicants must be a current or previous MSG or SFC listed on the MDARNG 1SG BQ List. All T32 (AGR) applicants must already be at the Grade of E8 at the time of selection.</p>					
SECTION IV: DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES					
<p>Requires the NCO to have a strong foundation in doctrine and be responsible for developing organizations, including company or staff sections, and developing systems to maintain proficiency across a wide range of areas. First Sergeants (1SGs) should demonstrate leadership skills that help in developing organizational leadership, effective communication, and coordination, both within and outside the organization. Moreover, they should maintain a high level of proficiency in their own Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear (CBRN) skills. 1SGs should also have expertise in executing Unit Training Management (UTM) and related systems such as Army Training Network (ATN), Army Training Information System (ATIS), and the Combined Arms Training Strategies (CATS) Development Tool. They should study and be familiar with publications related to equipment and duty skills associated with their current MOS (Military Occupational Specialty) and assignment, such as AR 600-20, AR 601-280, DA Pam 611-21, and AR 840-10.</p>					
SECTION V: REQUIRED QUALIFICATION					
<p>Commander recommends the applicant hold the 74D CMF or SQI "M". Must hold a Secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9, and AR 40-502. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions. Must be in grade of MSG/E8 or a promotable SFC/E7 at the time of selection. Should have extensive experience in CMF 74D, with thorough understanding and knowledge of Chemical Corp principles, policies, regulations, operations, and organization. Must possess an in-depth knowledge of the organization and mission of the 231st Chemical Company.</p>
