| Serves as the CSM/Commandant for the 70th Regiment, Regional Training Institute. Responsible for providing efficient and effective training support. Extends command influence, assesses morale of the force, adjusts administrative requirements to aid mission accomplishment and assist during critical events. Maintains accountability and visibility of AGR and MDAY personnel and is responsible for the health, welfare, morale, readiness, and professional development of all assigned Soldiers. Serves as the advisor to the Commander on all matters, to include operations, administration, promotions, retention, awards, and physical readiness training. CSM supervises Battalion and Brigade operations, overseas the management of the Senior Non-Commissioned Officers and provides tactical and technical guidance and professional support to subordinates and provides guidance on the accomplishment of their duties. CSMs should also have expertise in executing Unit Training Management (UTM) and related systems such as Army Training Network (ATN), Army Training Information System (ATIS), and the Combined Arms Training Strategies (CATS) Development Tool. |                     |  |  |                       |
