The ideal candidate for this 00F Immaterial position within the 70 RTI HHD is a seasoned Master Sergeant (8) or a highly competitive, promotable Sergeant First Class(E7) who demonstrates exceptional leadership and a clean personnel record. Free from any suspension of favorable actions, this professional possesses an active Secret security clearance and fully meets physical readiness, body composition, and medical retention standard.
