SECTION III: WHO MAY APPLY					
Open to traditional MDAY Soldiers, on board T32 NCOs holding the 15Z CMF, and those who are currently on the MDARNG 1SG BQ List. Additionally, all previous 1SGs holding the SQI "M" are eligible to apply. This is a traditional M-Day position. Applicants must be current or previous MSG or SFC listed on an ARNG 1SG BQ List. All T32 (AGR) Applicants must already be in the Grade of E8 at the time of selection.					
SECTION IV: DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES					
The Aviation First Sergeant acts as the advisor to the company commander, Platoon and Section echelon, supervises aviation company level operations and training; is the Aircraft Maintenance Senior Sergeant in a maintenance company/troop, aviation support company/troop or depot maintenance facility, provides tactical and technical guidance and professional support to subordinates, and makes recommendations to supervisors in the accomplishment of their duties. 1SGs should also have expertise in executing Flight Operations, Aircraft Maintenance Operations, Unit Training Management (UTM) and related systems such as Army Training Network (ATN), Digital Training Management System (DTMS), and the Combined Arms Training Strategies (CATS) Development Tool.					
SECTION V: REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS					
Must hold the 15Z CMF. Must hold a Secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-1, AR 600-9, and AR 40-502. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions. Must be in grade of E8 or a promotable SFC/E7 at the time of selection. Should have extensive experience in CMF 15Z with thorough understanding and knowledge of flight training, maintenance training (AMTP), organizational principles, policies, regulations, and operations. Must possess an in-depth knowledge of the mission of the 29th Expeditionary Combat Aviation Brigade.
