Restricted Statewide (Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Soldiers & Traditional M-Day Soldiers of the Maryland Army National Guard) Nationwide (Traditional M-DAY Soldiers of the Army National Guard)					
SECTION III: DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF POSITION					
This is a traditional M-Day position. Open to traditional M-DAY Soldiers and on board T32 AGR NCOs qualified in the 11, 12, 18, 25, 31, or 35 Series CMF. Applicants must be on the current MDARNG CSM Best Qualified List. All T32 (AGR) Applicants must already be in the Grade of E9 at the time of selection. Additionally, all previous CSMs are eligible to apply. This is a traditional M-Day position. You are required to be a member of Maryland Army National Guard if selected for this position. Assignment will not exceed 36 months unless Soldiers mobilize with the gaining unit or decide to remain in the MDARNG.					
SECTION IV: DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES					
The 110th Information Operations Battalion Command Sergeant Major acts as the principal advisor to the Battalion Commander (BC). They are the senior Noncommissioned Officer within the Battalion and as such, they advise the BC on all enlisted matters. The IO BN is comprised of the Headquarters and Headquarters Company, Alpha Company, and Bravo Company. This individual will be a subject matter expert on all things information operations. The CSM should work on helping the Senior NCOs develop organizational leadership skills needed to coach, teach, and mentor Soldiers. They are responsible for the health, discipline, morale, and welfare of the entire Battalion. They serve as the Senior Enlisted Trainer and work in conjunction with the unit First Sergeants and are instrumental in coaching, mentoring, and developing on the enlisted assignments within the Battalion.					
SECTION V: REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS					
Must hold the 11, 12, 18, 25, 31, or 35 Series CMF or ASI "6C". Must hold current TS/SCI clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-1, AR 600-9, and AR 40-502. Applicants must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions. Must be in grade of SGM/E9 or a promotable MSG/E8 at the time of selection. Must have experience in information operations, with thorough understanding and knowledge of the principles, policies, regulations, operations, and organization. Must possess an in-depth knowledge of the organization and mission of the 110th Information Operations Battalion.
