To be considered for this position, applicants must be a current SFC or be a Promotable SSG currently on the 92A EPS list. Please note that all Title 32 (AGR) applicants must already hold the grade of E7 at the time of selection to remain eligible.				
SECTION IV: DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES				
Serves as the First Sergeant and principal enlisted advisor to the Commander for Headquarters and Headquarters Company within the 1297th Combat Sustainment Support Battalion; responsible for the health, discipline, morale, and welfare of the entire Company. Advises and assists the command on operating, managing, and administering resources to accomplish all state and federally assigned missions. Serves as the Senior Enlisted Trainer; coordinates with Section Sergeants to plan training while coaching, teaching, and mentoring Senior NCOs and Soldiers within the Company. Concurrently supervises 92A management, stock record, and warehouse functions pertaining to receipt, storage, distribution, issue, and maintenance of equipment records to support 1297th CSSB operational logistics.

Applicants must be in the grade of SFC/E7 or a promotable SSG/E6 at the time of selection and cannot be under any suspension of favorable personnel actions. The candidates should hold the 92A MOS. All candidates must possess an active Secret security clearance to be considered for this position. You must also fully meet the physical and medical readiness standards outlined in AR 350-15, AR 600-9, and AR 40-502. Extensive experience in CMF 92 is required, demonstrating a thorough understanding of Quartermaster and Logistics Corps principles, regulations, and operations.
