DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

1SG Sergeant acts as the principal advisor to the Company Commander. They are the senior Noncommissioned Officer within the Company and as such, they advise the CDR on all enlisted matters. This individual will be a subject matter expert on all thing's Information operation. The 1SG should work on helping the Senior NCOs develop organizational leadership skills needed to coach, teach, and mentor Soldiers. They are responsible for the health, discipline, morale, welfare of the entire company. They serve as the Senior Enlisted Trainer and work in conjunction with the unit first line leader and is instrumental in coaching, mentoring, and developing on the enlisted assignments within the Company.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Must hold a Secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9, and AR 40-502. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions. Must be in grade of MSG/E8 or a promotable SFC/E7 at the time of selection. Must have extensive experience in all the CMF listed above, with thorough understanding and knowledge of Operation principles, policies, regulations, operations, and organization. Must possess an in-depth knowledge of the mission of the Unit and understand the Command relationships two levels up on the MTOE. Must have completed or is enrolled to complete Pre-Command Course.
