Open to all on board T10/T32 MDARNG E8/E9 NCOs listed on the MDARNG CSM BQ List. This is a traditional M-Day position. Applicants must be on the current CSM Best Qualified List from their respective state. All T32 (AGR) Applicants must already be in the Grade of E9 at the time of selection. Additionally, all previous CSMs are eligible to apply. This is a traditional M-Day position. You are required to be a member of Maryland Army National Guard if selected for this position. Candidates must submit an Interstate Transfer (IST) packet if NCO is assigned to another state. Upon completion of the term, it will be the sourcing state's responsibility to place the candidate (reassignment, IST, Individual Ready Reserve (IRR), retirement, etc.) Assignment will not exceed 36 months unless Soldiers mobilizes with the gaining unit or decides to remain in the MDARNG.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

The 629th Military Intelligence Battalion Command Sergeant Major acts as the principal advisor to the Battalion Commander (BC). They are the senior Noncommissioned Officer within the Military Intelligence Battalion and as such, they advise the BC on all enlisted matters. The MI BN is comprised of the Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, Alpha Counterintelligence and Human Intelligence Company, and Bravo Collection and Exploitation Company. This individual will be a subject matter expert on all thing's intelligence. The CSM should work on helping the Senior NCOs develop organizational leadership skills needed to coach, teach, and mentor Soldiers. They are responsible for the health, discipline, morale, welfare of the entire Battalion. They serve as the Senior Enlisted Trainer and work in conjunction with the unit First Sergeants and is instrumental in coaching, mentoring, and developing on the enlisted assignments within the Battalion.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Must hold the 35Z CMF or ASI "6C". Must hold TS SCI clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-1, AR 600-9, and AR 40-502.
